# Why Post on n1fd.org?

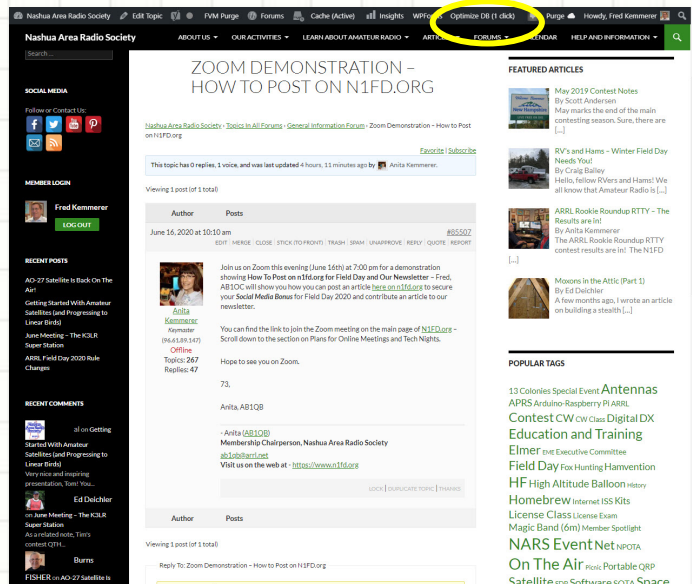
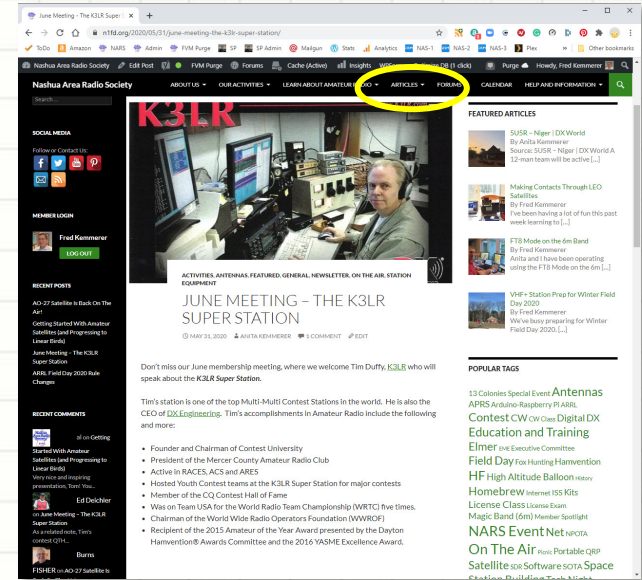


- Share your projects, activities, and ideas with others

- Contribute to the [NARS Monthly Newsletter](#)
- Secure your 2020 Field Day Social Media Bonus
  - All Blog posts are automatically posted on NARS Facebook and Twitter
- Get information out to all NARS members quickly
  - Forum posts result in an email to all members
- Its fun!

# Type of Posts

## Blog Posts (Articles)

- Media-rich format. Easy to include pictures, video, and more!
- Best for content having medium to long-term interest
- Articles appear in monthly NARS newsletter
- Articles are automatically cross-posted on NARS Facebook and Twitter
- Appear in search engines (ex. Google)



## Forum Posts

- Simple, text centric posts (can also include limited images and video)
- Best for content having shorter term value or and for Q&A
- Great for “getting the word out” quickly
  - Summary notifications go to all NARS members via e-mail
- Categorize posts by Forum - **Swap-meet**, **Elmering**, **Field Day**, and **General Info** Forums are popular.
- Most forums are public. **Members** forum is only visible to NARS members.



# Posting Checklist



- Decide whether to create a **Blog Post** or a **Forum Post**
  - Perhaps sketch out an outline if your post will be longer than a paragraph or two...
- Gather your media files
  - Name your files to provide captions or titles for your images
  - Adjust resolution to 1024x768 if you can easily do this with existing software tools
- Login to n1fd.org
- Start your Blog Post (article) via the **Articles Menu** on n1fd.org
- Start your Forum Post by selecting the Forum that you want to post in from the **Forums Menu** on n1fd.org
- Create your post on n1fd.org and submit it for moderation
  - Upload your images
  - Write your article
  - Add section headings, hyperlinks, proofread, and adjust formatting

## Useful Keyboard Shortcuts:

Ctrl+C – Copy selected text

Ctrl+V – Paste copied text

Ctrl+K – Create hyperlink for selected text
